The NIH grant is submitted institutionally. **All final application documents MUST reach the RGMO seven (7) workdays before NIH application due date. The application will be submitted two (2) days before the application due date.**

- The [International Summit in Human Genetics and Genomics](#), sponsored in part by the National Human Genome Research Institute (NHGRI) and the Foundation for the NIH, will train **early-mid career stage health care professionals and trainees from developing nations**. Research scientists, physicians, dentists, dentist-scientists, nurses, counselors and medical, dental and graduate school trainees can apply.
